VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Mentor – Assigned to one woman in the house. Would visit on site weekly for a minimum of one hour; to offer encouragement, fellowship, and guidance.

Sponsor – Must have been sober at least two years, with an understanding of Celebrate Recovery, Reformers Unanimous and/or Recovery for Life. Be available to sponsee for daily check in.

Transportation – Provide transportation for a woman to go to or return from work, doctor, probation office, court, DHS, Celebrate Recovery, etc.

In House - 2-4 weekday hours per week (or month) in the house. Any or all of the following: answer phone, greet those who come to the door, oversee cooking, cleaning, conduct devotional, pray with women, art/craft project, etc. May also be asked to do small clerical tasks and give tours. There can be some down time, so we encourage you to bring a book to read, balance your checkbook, knit/crochet, or work on personal matters. In house volunteers provide a presence in the house and support for the women who are 'at home'; which allows the Executive Director and House Leader to be out in the community, promoting Nicole's House.

In – Kind – Coordinate canned, boxed, bottled or package food donations, cleaning & paper products.

Minor Repairs - Available to work on sticking doors, fix appliances, climb a ladder, etc

Landscaping -Mowing, weeding, plant, water, mulch

Sales – Help with sales tables at various events such as craft fairs, open house, etc. help find other areas our handmade cards and gift boxes could be sold.

Speaker - Coordinate presentations where you or the Exec Dir would present information to civic organizations, churches, etc.

Fund Raisers – Assist with event planning or a fund-raising campaign. Joy Comes in the Morning is May 6, 2020 Grant writing. Others might be a monthly donor pledge campaign, holiday open house, etc.

Sustainability - Assist with creating greeting cards, totes, etc

Board of Directors – Commit to monthly meetings, second Monday of the month. Assist with establishing and updating protocol, rules and regulations, fund raising, event planning, grant writing, promote Nicole's House to your family, neighborhood, work place and/or offer your expertise in certain areas like recovery, career planning, budgeting, case management, social media, IT, etc. 3-5 hours mo.
